## Key Stage 2 Academic Results and SATs Results

Please note that, since the change in format of SATs examinations and the removal of national curriculum levels, Kingswood School no longer enters children for SATs examinations. (We simply found that every child was being awarded the same grade – “E” for expected level.) Instead, we are continuing to assess our pupils’ performance by administering the old-style SATs papers which are marked internally and which enable us to provide parents and secondary schools with meaningful levels.

Last year’s attainment levels are shown below, together with historic SATs levels. It should be noted that Kingswood School is a non-selective school. Most children start at Kingswood at age 3, well below the age that academic testing is possible. Unlike some other independent schools, we do not ask parents to remove their children if, at a later stage, we find that a child has learning needs. We pride ourselves in treating each child as an individual and we are confident that, when children leave us, they have each achieved their own potential.
